

## HAPPY TRAILS RV CLUB MEETING ON APRIL 4, 2013

First rally for next season will be the **Blue Grass Festival at Wickenburg**. Campsite will be at Wickenburg Community Center. Rally fee is \$200, deposit of \$100 due by end of April. Donna Roberts is the wagon master.

December/January rally will be the **Rose Bowl Rally** December 28 to Jan 2<sup>nd</sup>. Seven deposits have been paid. Joel and Neva Saltzman are the wagon masters. \$300 deposit due by end of April.

Betty announced a good rally would be in **Tucson at Lazy Days** facility campground. Could include Lazy Day Safety Course, trips to Biosphere, Karchner Caverns, etc. Jerry O'Brien suggested appointments could be made for RV repairs while at this facility. **Wagon Masters are needed.**
