Minutes of General Meeting March 4, 2011

Time and Location: NC-2, 5:00 P.M.

Members and guests present: over 50

The meeting was called to order by President, Donna Roberts at 5:00 P.M.

Donna reported that the Bisbee/Tombstone campout was a great success. She invited Ed Pfister to speak. He reported that the Lake Havasu campout dates would be changed from Nov. 2011 to February 2012 due to the Havasu fireworks extravaganza. Dates are tentatively set for Feb. 17-19.

The November campout will now be a "Welcome Back" campout held Nov. 8-11. A \$25 deposit is required. This can be paid to Sherry Pfister at the meeting or any time thereafter. The cost will be a total of \$92.50 for two people. It is currently limited to twelve rigs as it is a new campground. They will notify us if more sites become available.

There was input from a member that there are many things going on in the Park that club members would need to attend and suggested that we might try and avoid planning campouts those two weeks. Donna responded that we were often told by the parks we were booking at, what days could be available to us. She also stated that unfortunately there would always be conflicts for any number of reasons.

Hank and Betty Bernat, Wagon Masters for the Havasu Campout, are going to Havasu on Mar. 9th in preparation for next year's trip.

Joel Salzman reported the Rose Parade Campout was full, but he would take names in case he gets a cancellation. To get on the cancellation list, a deposit of \$300 is required. This deposit would be refunded if there were no cancellations.

Donna spoke about Lake Powell Campout from April 25th – 28th, reminding members that the total cost for two is \$280. An \$80 deposit is required and spaces are filling fast. Included will be a boat trip on Antelope Canyon, a trip to the magnificent Slot Canyons, hiking and other events. The remaining \$200 is due by March 15th.

Donna also reminded members that they can place their orders for shirts with Judy Wilton.

Four new members were introduced. Membership now stands at 96.

The nominating committee has submitted nominations for the office of Vice-President, Bill Trice and for the office of Secretary, Debbie Gunning. There were no further nominations from the floor. Voting will occur at the April meeting. New officers will take office next November.

The April meeting will be held on Thursday, April 7 at NC-2 at 4:30 P.M.

Terry Depriest adjourned the meeting.
